INSTRUCTIONS:



WHAT ARE YOU TRYING TO DESCRIBE?

Rather than just saying "life is funny" (a little cliché), you might say "life is like a box of chocolates" – then the next line explains it – "you never know what you're gonna get".

- o There are two was to get: a direct comparison X is like Y (A), or
- Using a simile to describe something in a different way and/or provide a visual (B)
- (A)How love feels
- (B) Sliding across a car hood

CREATE YOUR SIMILE LIST & ADD THE WHY/HOW

Start with the first simile you're trying to find and give yourself some options. Use one worksheet per simile. Remember, you can use "like" or "as" – so don't restrict yourself to either as you're brainstorming. You'll also explain the simile if it's connecting two ideas rather than being used as a description enhancement like (B).

(A) Love	
LIKE WHAT?	Is like a chunk of gold
WHY/HOW?	It's precious and hard to hold
(B) Being cl	nased and sliding across a car hood
LIKE WHAT?	Hood sliding like Bo Duke
WHY/HOW?	(Not needed - visual enhancement of the verb)



PICK ONE & TRY IT IN YOUR LYRIC WITH YOUR MELODY!

You may need to tweak how you're saying it or your melody depending on how strongly you feel about the simile you've created.
